Re: Early Intervention Weekly Update

For the week ending July 31, 2020, the Bureau, together with a diverse group of stakeholders, has been collecting questions from the field related to the <u>Guidance</u> for resuming in-person services in early intervention. We have been working to consolidate all of the questions received to date and to generate responses. Additionally, we have established a dedicated email to collect questions from this point forward: <u>DHS.EIQuestions@illinois.gov</u>. Questions submitted will shape the content of future FAQs, resource development, and revisions to the Guidance as we continue to move through the Restore Illinois phases.

A number of questions have arisen about how to prioritize families for in-person services. Given the State's commitment to equity and access, teams are being asked to prioritize in-person services to the children/families who have not been supported via phone or live video visits during the pandemic. Additional considerations include the family's readiness to resume services and the length of time remaining before the child transitions out of the early intervention system.

We have also been actively working with our system partners and Reopen Illinois Early Intervention workgroup members to develop resources that will support implementation of the Guidance.
